

How the SmartMove Safety Passport Works

Students access the SmartMove website as either part of a prescribed course such as Workplace Learning, or as part of their workplace health and safety training requirements.

Students, (or educators), order the Safety Passport through the website, so that students, educators and workplace supervisors can record and monitor the student's work health and safety education progression.

Each classroom competency (aligned with the competency unit BSBWHS201A) is signed and dated in the passport by the student's teacher/trainer as the student successfully completes each SmartMove lesson.

The SmartMove Safety Passport is a working document, it is updated as milestones are reached and competencies completed, so students are not excluded from the workplace if they are struggling through a lesson

When placed with a host employer, the employer is able to sign off on specific workplace competencies when a student demonstrates practical WHS knowledge while at work.

The SmartMove Safety Passport is used to convey to host employers a student's assessed WHS knowledge, and is a document for communication between a school and employer in the absence of regular verbal contact

Upon completion of the SmartMove Certificate quiz, students are able to print out and attach a passport sized certificate of completion for their industry module, and attach it inside their passport.

When the classroom and workplace competencies are all completed, the teacher/trainer can apply for a WorkSafe SmartMove certificate of excellence on the student's behalf.
